Today's speaker was Dr. Jason Ross - Ross Family Dental

Dr. Ross is an Albuquerque native; grew up in the north east area of town and attended the various schools there...from grade school to high school. Dr. Ross earned a BS degree in Biology from UNM in 1998 and graduated from Creighton Dental School in 2003. Jason has a successful dental practice located on Montgomery Ave, here in Albuquerque where he and his partner strive to provide a proactive approach to dental care and not just the basic drill and fill type work. At this point things could get confusing, if you were not paying attention to Dr. Ross' presentation. Dr. Ross is an Albuquerque native; graduated from Del Norte High School in 2002; received a degree from NMSU in 2006 and graduated from Creighton Dental School in 2005. Dr. Ross has a 9 year old daughter, Morgan, and a 7 year old son, Caden. The children enjoy playing soccer, particularly in games that include the children of Dr. Ross' dental partner. Perhaps this will help make things more clear. Dr. Ross is quite pretty and Dr. Ross successfully competed in the Houston Iron Man competition earlier this year; finishing in the top one-third of more than 1,900 male contestants. Now more about Ross Family Dental. Dr. Jason Ross and his business partner, or more importantly, his life partner, Dr. Kerry Ross, operate a dental practice geared entirely toward their patients. The doctors strive to provide those patients with all the information, screenings, analysis and options available for the patient to be proactive about their dental care. The patients' future can be so much more positive when they have taken steps to prevent major tooth and mouth problems. The Doctors Ross provide information about various techniques for preventative care. They offer guidance for correcting matters that have already gone awry. And when there are emergency situations, or other instances requiring more immediate attention, the Doctors are able to professionally provide the best solutions to those problems as well. Jason and Kerry spend more than \$15,000 a year on continuing education in order to be sure that they are aware of new procedures and information, and so that they stay educated and trained in the most up-to-date techniques available. Jason also gave us some 'basic' information for understanding how to best deal with dental matters: Visit your dentist regularly for preventative analysis, not just for problems; brush your teeth for at least 2 minutes, twice a day, using a softer bristled or electric tooth brush; floss between teeth at least once a day; know the options, and consequences, for dealing with major cavities; don't have a tooth pulled when a filling or crown are an option-a missing tooth can allow the surrounding teeth to progressively shift and lean, leading to other complications. Tooth whitening products are OK, if they are one of the major brands and are designed to stay in contact with teeth for an extended period of time; actually the specially fitted trays for whitening are best.
