An EAGA Web Site Tutorial



Don Clark and Robert Kwasny had a 'show-and-tell' presentation to let members know the hows and whats of our 'new' web-site. The website has been active for quite a few months, but there are some members who have not yet taken advantage of the EAGA specific information provided there. The data included in the site, is not intended for public access, so only the Home Page, a general contact form and the Membership Application are accessible to non-members. Internal access is controlled

by the standard process of user names and passwords. Your user name is the first initial of your first name and your full last name (all lower case and no spaces). Each member will be assigned a password the first time they visit the site. That initial password can be changed by the user at anytime in the future. Please use a 'strong' password, being ever mindful of appropriate password security. (The Account Login Page actually provides a tutorial about passwords, security strength and suggestions for storing and reviewing your passwords.) To obtain the initial password, click the "Lost Your Password?" link and enter your user name in the box provided. An email will be sent to your address of record. Once that email arrives, just follow the instructions to set your password. Upon entry to the site you will find much useful EAGA data. There is a tab that takes you to an EAGA members list. Clicking a member's link will take you to their specific information. Whatever is available within each member's area is controlled by that individual, so the amount of data, or lack thereof, depends on what the member has entered. Our site also has selections that take you to pages containing: a list of current Board Members and Officers, including photos; a brief list of upcoming events; Official Records, such as By-Laws; a collection of photos and information about past events; and a wealth of current and past bulletins are also available. Please take the time to visit the site. Enter at least basic information about your business, and yourself; more than the basics if you like. Be sure to click the 'Save Changes' button before navigating away from the page. Tour the site to get a feel for what is there. Send an email to Mario (contact information below) if you have any suggestions for improving the site, or the experience. Thank you to Don and Robert for the presentation and the information. And Robert...at some time in the distant future, very distant future, I am sure that you won't have to hear comments about you looking better with the 'green screen' mask on.
