## Today's speaker was Timmy Sims—Territorial Scaffold.



Territorial Scaffold was one of the three new members inducted at this morning's meeting and their representative, Timmy Sims, wasted no time in taking a turn at the speaker's podium. Actually, the company was a member of EAGA for a long time, but they had to drop out for a time when circumstances made it difficult for Timmy to attend the meetings on a regular basis. But now things are different Timmy is glad to be back and ready to be a very active participant in EAGA. Territorial Scaffold was founded by Timothy Sims, Timmy's father, back in 1973 and they have been helping people to rise to greater heights ever since. The younger Mr. Sims is a local boy. He grew up in Albuquerque, attending Hope High School, CNM and UNM. He is married and has five children and is also an avid outdoorsman (a few years ago he even looked the part of a Mountain Man impersonator with the bushy whiskers and all). These days, when Timmy is not being a husband, father and outdoorsman, he can be found doing work for Territorial Scaffold. The company, as the name clearly indicates, provides scaffolding. All kinds of scaffolding. I was not able to attend the meeting this morning, so am working off notes kindly provided by other members that were smart enough to be there. During his presentation this morning, Timmy had slides showing many examples of the pretty impressive products that they've recently provided for customers. One photo showed scaffolding that Territorial built in a canyon for the Netflix movie, Chupa. Although all the examples displayed amazing work, that job, noting incredible knowledge and skill, was probably the most impressive according to our Executive Director. If you saw Timmy's presentation, or if you view their website, you will find out that there is more to scaffolding than just some strategically placed poles supporting random wooden planks. The term 'scaffolding' encompasses quite a wide variety of products—and Timmy's company provides it all. There's the swing stage type, for hanging down to work off the side of a building, sign or the like. French scaffold is another type: common to stucco work, it uses the standard frames and scissor style cross braces to keep it sturdy. Tube and clamp type of scaffolding, appropriately named, used tube support beams held together by tightly bolted clamps. And there is also the System type scaffolding that uses a setup with poles with rings. After further investigation, you will also discover that Territorial offers devices called 'Post Shore' that appear to be used to hold up ceilings or upper decks, presumably until something more permanent is in place. And Territorial can also provide customers with related products such as trash chutes. Those look to be a very convenient and organized way to get unwanted or unused material down from whatever project is happening at the top of the scaffolding setup. You should note though, that Territorial only provides products and services to commercial customers - no residential. So you won't be able to acquire one of those chutes to make a thrilling ride for the neighborhood kids to slide down from the roof of your two story home. You probably wouldn't be able to find the necessary well crafted britches anyway.
