Member speaker on 8/12/2025 JW Biava w/ AirWell



The meeting highlighted the wide-ranging health effects of both indoor and outdoor air pollution, stressing that risks go far beyond allergies. Outdoor pollutants such as particulate matter, VOCs, sulfur dioxide, ozone, and others are linked to respiratory, cardiovascular, and neurological problems. Indoors, hazards like mold, radon, formaldehyde, tobacco smoke, and asbestos can cause chronic illness, neurological issues, and even cancer, with mold being particularly common in U.S. homes. JW explained the difference between acute (short-term) and chronic (long-term) exposure, noting that chronic indoor exposure is a growing concern since Americans spend about 90% of their time inside, where pollutant levels can be significantly higher. The East Palestine, Ohio, chemical burn incident served as a case study of both immediate and lasting environmental impacts.

Airwell's services include certified testing for regulated pollutants such as mold, asbestos, and lead, along with a holistic indoor wellness model to assess and eliminate health hazards.
